

Consent for Telemedicine Consultation

Acceptance of terms and conditions

The undersigned patient or responsible relative (in case of a patient aged under 18 years) hereby consents to and authorizes doctors and medical personnel of World Health Partners (WHP) to provide a telemedicine consultation through an interactive video system. The undersigned also understands other individuals may be present to assist the doctor during the consultation and they will take reasonable steps to maintain confidentiality of the information.

The undersigned understands that in the course of the patient/client's care, WHP may administer and perform medical examinations, investigations, medical treatments, outpatient procedures, vaccinations and immunizations on an outpatient basis as is deemed necessary or advisable by WHP's personnel. The undersigned recognizes that a doctor is not physically present at the consultation site and provides the services only remotely thus making the consultation not valid for medico-legal purposes.

The undersigned authorizes WHP to store the data electronically in a retrieval form and further authorizes the release of any relevant medical information to the consulting health care provider, any support staff and personnel who may need this information for continuing care. The undersigned also agrees for WHP or its assignee's use of the medical information for quality monitoring, research or insurance coverage safeguarding the identity wherever necessary.

The undersigned also consents to WHP contacting her/him in person or on telephone if needed for follow-up, case monitoring or assessing quality of services rendered. The undersigned understands that a specific doctor/physician shall be available subject to his/her availability/willingness/discretion and cannot be demanded as a pre-condition.

The undersigned understands that he/she has the right to ask for discontinuation of the tele-consultation and removal of all Sensitive Personal Data or Information ("SPDI") at any time.

The undersigned declares that the services sought are not meant for any emergency and life-threatening conditions which would require treatment in a hospital.

The undersigned has read this document and understands the risks and benefits of telemedicine consultation and confirms that all my questions regarding the procedure have been adequately explained. The undersigned releases World Health Partners, its service delivery personnel and any others participating in the care from any and all liability which may arise from the provision of tele-consultation services.
